Helen Keller could not see, hear or speak. But she did many things that are difficult even for normal people. She studied at a university, and traveled to more than 25 countries. She worked to help blind people all over the world. And she wrote books that were translated into more than 50 languages.

Helen was born in Alabama, USA, in 1880. When she was a baby, she became very sick and almost died. After that, she was blind-she couldn't see. She was also deaf-she couldn't hear. And because she couldn't hear, she didn't learn to talk like normal children. Her parents couldn't teach her about what is good and what is bad.

When she was seven years old, a teacher came into her life. Anne Sullivan found a way to teach Helen. She used a special "hand alphabet" to teach Helen the names of things. The first word Helen learned was water. Anne put Helen's hand in some water and spelled W-A-T-E-R for her. Helen was a very intelligent girl. She learned many new words very quickly until she could read and write using Braille.

When she was ten years old, she began learning to talk by putting her hands on her teacher's face. In this way she could feel the sounds with her fingers and try to do the same. As she could speak, she went to school, and after that went to university. After her graduation, she did her best to bring hope to the blind. She died in 1968.

Hong Kong is an interesting mix of old things and new things. Visitors to Hong Kong can see tall bank buildings next to tiny shops. People in Hong Kong live in large , modern apartment buildings, and on traditional, small boats. More and more tourists come to Hong Kong every year. **They** enjoy seeing the interesting mix of old and new.

Hong Kong is on the south coast of China. **It** is made up of Hong Kong Island, more than 200 other small islands, and an area on the mainland. It belonged to Great Britain in the past. Now, it is a part of China.

About 6 million people live in Hong Kong. About 90%of these people are Chinese . Most of them come from the south of China. Hong Kong has two official languages, English and Chinese. Many people use English at work, but most of them speak Chinese at home.

About 95% of Hong Kong people live in the city. They work in banks, companies and factories. The others live in the countryside and work as farmers. Some of those farmers still use traditional ways in farming, but many of them depend on **modern** machines.

There are many interesting things to see and do in Hong Kong. Visitors can go to the top of Victoria Peak-a mountain to the west of Hong Kong city. From that top, they can look down at the city. They can see the ships in the harbour. And many small islands. If the weather is good, they can see China. They can also eat in a restaurant at the top.

Visitors also like to travel on The Star **Ferry**. The Star Ferry is a small boat that takes people from Hong Kong Island across the harbour to the mainland. The trip takes only seven minutes, but you can see the beautiful view of the city and the harbour.
